Dear friends in Christ,

The other day I was asked about how and why we rang the church bell during the Lord's Prayer in worship. The answer lies in the historical tradition of village churches that were surrounded by farmland. When working in the fields the sound of the bells allowed those unable to be in worship the opportunity to pray the Lord's Prayer along with the community as the bell is rung throughout the prayer.

I know where I live, over a mile from the center of Harmony Borough; I can clearly hear the bell of Grace Church in the square. The clear tones of a bell carry great distances. The sounds of a bell carry worship outward and include those going about necessary tasks. Worship and prayer is not limited to the church building but occurs in the home, field and workplace.

In this season of Lent we are invited to commit to spiritual practices that help us remember the gift we have received in the death and resurrection of Jesus. That may include giving up something like chocolate and attending special Lenten worship services at church, but these bells remind me that worship and our spiritual life is not restricted to the walls of a church building. It is outside the church in the weekday, in the everyday, in regular life that we live out our faith. It is in the midst of work and play that we can give constant thanks and praise to God.

I recently was out driving and noticed that some fields are already being plowed, a sign that spring is on its way and it is a busy time for farmers. I could not help but think about bells ringing, tractors plowing, and prayers prayed. Part of the statement of purpose in all Lutheran congregation constitutions came to my mind: "... to see daily life as the primary setting for the exercise of their Christian calling..."

Baptized in Christ, we gather as the people of God to be strengthened by God's Word and fed for the journey; after Sunday, we are sent into Monday morning life to live out our faith in word and deed. Our Lenten disciplines help us to recall what Jesus Christ has done for us, given us life - a life to be lived prayerfully and joyfully.

Meet at the church for class. For additional information please contact Christine Dishong or Pastor Zimmerman.



YouthFest is a retreat weekend at Camp Lutherlyn for youth in grades 7-12 - April 8-10. It is a wonderful opportunity for our youth to engage in faith forming activities, team building, fun and awesome worship. The cost per person is \$124 for the weekend.

Remnant Confirmation Camp, held June 26- July 1 this year at Camp Lutherlyn, is a unique opportunity for youth to experience and grow in their faith and understanding. A group of pastors have formed this special camp to offer experiences to supplement and enrich the regular confirmation class program. This week of camp in a community of fellow confirmation students, camp staff and pastors, our youth live out their faith in hands on activities, bible study, service opportunities and regular camp fun. It is strongly encouraged that all confirmation students join Pastor Zimmerman and attend this camp at least once during their three year confirmation journey and even the summer following.

The cost for this week of fun and learning is \$338 per camper. This is less expensive than a regular week of camp at Lutherlyn, because the pastors serve as leaders of the group. Though a good value for the experience this is still a good deal of money.
